Website Review Time!



The end of the year is fast approaching! Now is the ideal time to give your school website a review to ensure it is up to date and ready for the 2022 school year. Take your website through this checklist...

- Check all pages for old content
 - remove any content with 2021 dates (or earlier in some cases!) that is no longer relevant
- If your offered year levels are changing next year is this clear on your website?
- Add 2022 term dates and public holidays (if you have this section on your site)
- Add Term 1 tour days
- Look at the enrolment info is it easily accessible?
- Look at your website from a first-time visitor or prospective parent is it easy to enquire/register interest/apply to find out more information about enrolling?
- Is it very clear on your home page what you want people to do? (Is it read more information, enquire, sign up for a tour, enrol?) –
 make that a standout message when visitors land on your site.
- Is the information about what makes your school different/awesome easy to find?
- Does any imagery need updating? If your website photos need a refresh, the CESA marketing team can help you organise a photo shoot in 2022.
- Is it responsive (resizes on a mobile device)? Over 50% of website views are now through mobile devices vs desktop. CESA recommends the use of Boylen web templates let us know if you would like more information.
